HOW TO MEASURE BLINDS

Venetians, Verticals, Hollands, Romans

RECESS FIX			
1. Do you want the blind to fit into the recess of the window? See illustration 1 below.			
2. Make sure there are no obstructions to hinder where the blind will hang – e.g. window winders, window frames in the middle of the window.			
3. Measure the exact distance from inside edge to inside edge for both width and drop. DO NOT make any deductions, and mark you measurements as NAM (No allowance made), and Recess Fix. The factory will make the necessary adjustments.			
FACE FIX			
5. Do you want the blind to sit on the architrave of the window?			
6. Measure the exact distance from outside edge of the architrave to the other outside edge for both width and drop. See illustration 2 below DO NOT make any deductions, and mark your measurements as NAM (No allowance made) and Face Fix. If you want the blind longer than the architrave, add the extra measurement to the drop.			
CONTROL SIDE			
7. Which side of the blind to you want the control to be? Make sure there is easy access for easy operation.	RH/LH	RH/LH	RH/LH
